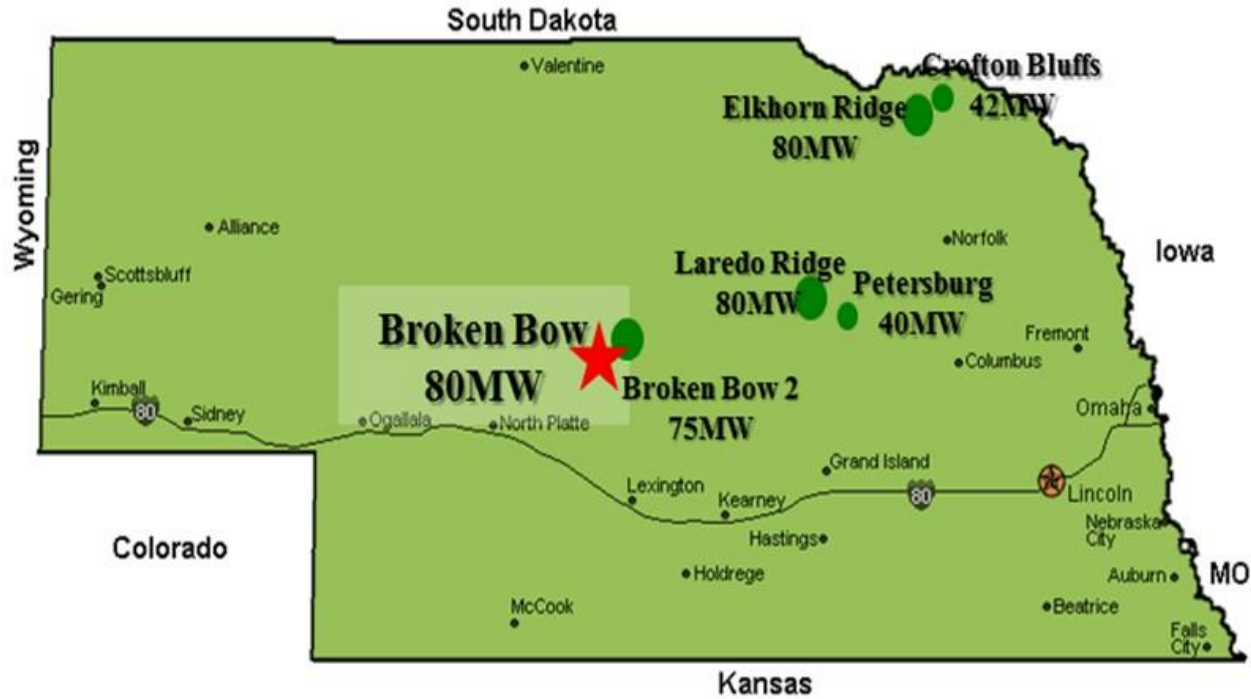

- Laredo Ridge (2009)
 - 81 Megawatts
 - 28,350 homes
- Elkhorn Ridge (2010)
 - 81 Megawatts
 - 28,350 homes
- Broken Bow (2012)
 - 80 Megawatts
 - 28,000 homes
- Crofton Bluffs (2012)
 - 40 Megawatts
 - 14,000 homes

Post-construction Monitoring at New Sites

- Broken Bow and Crofton Bluffs
- Commences in Spring 2013
- 1 year, with another year if significant biological findings



Post-construction Monitoring: Broken Bow/Crofton

- In accordance with new USFWS Land-based Wind Energy Guidelines
- Monitoring includes spring, summer, and fall monitoring for birds
